



CS Dieppe Parents' Code of Conduct

The objective of the CS Dieppe Code of Conduct is to promote a safe, positive and fun soccer environment for everyone. CS Dieppe is committed to respecting the code of conduct for its players, volunteer coaches and spectators. In cases where players or coaches do not follow the principles and rules of the Code of Conduct, CS Dieppe will continue to follow the established club and league disciplinary procedures. CS Dieppe expects all players' parents to respect the following code of conduct:

- I will remember that my child plays soccer for his(her) pleasure, not mine. I will NOT force my child to play soccer if he/she no longer wants to play.
- I will NOT give instructions to players - it is the responsibility of the coaches.
- I will encourage my child to play by the rules and resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- So that my child never feels defeated by the outcome of the game, I will teach him(her) that doing his best is as important as winning.
- I will make my child feel successful every time by offering praise for being competitive and making an effort.
- I will never ridicule my child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- I will remember that children learn better by example. I will applaud the great performances of my child's team and its opponents.
- I will not question the judgment of officials in public. I'm not going to scream or argue with the referees.
- I will support all efforts to eliminate verbal and physical abuse of children's sports activities.
- I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteer coaches who have given of their time to allow my child to participate in sporting activities.
- I will ensure that my child arrives in time for the scheduled practices and games at a time designated by the coach.
- I realize that the team may be penalized for my behaviour and that I must respect the rules and officials on the field.
- I have to stand on the opposite side of the field from players and coaches.
- I will not walk on the field during play except for extraordinary reasons, and only if an official or coach asks me to do so.
- I will wait 24 hours before contacting an official or coach to make any complaints following a game or training session.
- I will not behave negatively during a game and I will treat referees, coaches, parents and players of opposing teams with respect.

I acknowledge that any violation of this code of conduct may result in a warning from the CS Dieppe coach, referee or executive officer. Any infractions that continue after a warning could lead to an expulsion from one or more games and/or training sessions.
