



## **COVID-19 : UPDATE APRIL 17, 2020**

**Dieppe, April 17, 2020** – On April 2<sup>nd</sup>, the New Brunswick government announced that schools will remain closed for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. Soccer Dieppe club has therefore decided **to cancel its after-class program - Spring session in all schools.**

Despite the cancellation of the after-class program, **there is still no question of canceling the summer soccer season 2020.** The members, volunteers and administrators of Soccer Dieppe should expect a special and unique season, where we will be asked to be more flexible in order to provide a safe and fun environment for everyone. Registrations for summer season will be open from today. You can register now and pay later!

Regarding the resumption of activities, Soccer Dieppe cannot at this time announce a specific date for the launch of its programs. Soccer Dieppe is closely monitoring the development of this pandemic and a date will be set when the next government's recommendations allow us to do so.

In midst of this confinement and self isolation, Soccer Dieppe's directors, in collaboration with Soccer NB, clubs, city of Dieppe and other partners, continue to work on multiple scenarios of resumption of activities according to different dates and context of play.

Soccer Dieppe has also set up a working group to launch continuous improvement projects, analyze and evaluate club operations and adapt our programming to the current situation.
